

# Appendix B: *Tuscania* Crew List

## Introduction

This crew list of those men and women scheduled to sail on the *Tuscania's* final voyage (January 24-February 5, 1918) as employees of the Anchor Line was originally created by Steven M. Schwartz of Renton, Washington.

Schwartz's list arranged names in order by rank/job ("trimmer") aboard; this list is in alphabetical order by surname, rearranged by Marilyn Gahm.

As Schwartz notes: "The names above were transcribed from old documents; these documents may have not recorded the correct spelling of some of these names."

This list includes 239 men and two women, for a total crew of 241 people.

Several of the merchant marines had "alias" names.

### Guide to notes:

AWOL – "away without official leave" – these men are listed as deserting in New York City before the final voyage.

Buried on Islay – the graves of these men are marked by tombstones on the isle of Islay, Scotland. Four merchant marines (Logan, Mullen/Mullin, Simpson, Stewart) are buried in Kilnaughton Military Cemetery; one (Jenkins) is buried in Kilchoman Military Cemetery. An unknown sailor is also buried in Kilnaughton. Originally his tombstone read "Unknown Negro;" this stone has been replaced with one inscribed "A Sailor of the Great War."

MIA – missing in action – the names of these men are inscribed on the Tower Hill monument in London, England, to British World War I personnel whose bodies were not recovered.
